

# Achillea tomentosa Woolly Yarrow



## PLANT DESCRIPTION

**Plant Type:** Perennial Groundcover

**Height / Width:** 6 in. H x 18 in. W

**Plant Form:** Flat, spreading mat

**Flower / Fruit:** Golden flower heads in flat umbels top 6-10 in. stems in June through September

**Leaf Color, Size:** Fernlike, gray-green, soft & fuzzy

**Native To:** Europe, western Asia

## GROWING REQUIREMENTS

**Sunset Zones:** 1-24

**Soil:** Well-drained, but will tolerate wide range of soils

**Water:** Little to moderate. Drought-tolerant when established.

**Sun:** Full sun

**Care and Pruning:** Shear off dead flowers to leave attractive soft gray-green mat  
Divide every 2 to 4 years

Good edging plant  
Rock gardens  
Neat groundcover in small areas  
Planting pockets on stone walls
