## **PLANT DESCRIPTION**

<b>Plant Type:</b>	<b>Evergreen Perennial</b>
<b>Height / Width:</b>	<b>&lt; 4 in. H x 12-24 in. W</b>
<b>Plant Form:</b>	<b>Graceful, fan shaped</b>
<b>Flower / Fruit:</b>	<b>Insignificant, sedge-like flower spikes of tiny, densely-packed, greenish-yellow flowers in spring; giving way to tiny fleshy berries</b>
<b>Leaf Color, Size:</b>	<b>Chartreuse, sedge-like, narrow, fanning; spicy sweet fragrance</b>
<b>Native To:</b>	<b>Northern Hemisphere</b>

## **GROWING REQUIREMENTS**

<b>Sunset Zones:</b>	<b>3b-10, 14-24</b>
<b>Soil:</b>	<b>Moist</b>
<b>Water:</b>	<b>Moderate once established, grows well in boggy conditions</b>
<b>Sun:</b>	<b>Part shade to shade</b>
<b>Care / Pruning:</b>	<b>Low maintenance. Tough plant.</b>

**Brightens moist shady areas. Perfect for edging walkways, in groupings, between stepping stones or as a groundcover. Fabulous foliage. Deer resistant.**
