PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Deciduous tree or shrub
Height / Width:	10-20 ft. H x 30+ ft. W
Plant Form:	Upright, multi-trunked
Flower / Fruit:	Fragrant, cream-colored plumes in spring, large pear-shaped fruits split open to reveal shiny brown seeds
Leaf Color, Size:	Pale apple-green maturing to rich green, 5-7 leaflets
Native To:	Dry slopes of California

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	3-10, 14-24
Soil:	Moderate to poor
Water:	Low to moderate (Moderate to hold leaves through summer)
Sun:	Full sun
Care / Pruning:	Easy to grow
