PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Perennial from bulb
Height / Width:	6-12 in. H x 6-9 in. W
Plant Form:	Upright clump
Flower / Fruit:	Nearly white, held high above foliage, blooming from April to May
Leaf Color, Size:	Grass-like, green, aromatic, hairy underside, from October to June
Native To:	Mediterranean region

Sunset Zones:	1-24
Soil:	Not fussy
Water:	Low to moderate
Sun:	Full sun to full shade
Care and Pruning:	Can be invasive
