PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type: Deciduous Vine

Height / Width: 15-25 feet

Plant Form: Vigorous, tendril-climbing

Flower / Fruit: Greenish flowers clusters in July; showy clusters of oval 1/4-in. lilac-blue fruits in fall, mature to amethyst to porcelain blue color

Leaf Color, Size: 3-lobed, deep green to 5 in.

Native To: Asia

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones: 2-24

Soil: Well-drained, adapts to most soils

Water: Moderate to regular

Sun: Sun or shade in hottest climates

Care and Pruning: Needs strong support. Flowers on new growth; may be cut to ground in late winter to control growth.
