PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Herbaceous Perennial
Height / Width:	2-4 ft. H x 4-6 ft. W
Plant Form:	Graceful clump
Flower / Fruit:	Single or semi-double in white, silvery pink, or rose blooms in late summer, fall
Leaf:	Dark green with 3-5 lobes
Native To:	Garden Hybrid

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	2b-24
Soil:	Not fussy
Water:	Regular
Sun:	Partial shade
Care and Pruning:	Slow to establish then fast spread. Cut spent bloom stalks to basal foliage. Cut foliage to ground in winter. Mulch in cold winter areas. May need staking. Divide in early spring or after flowering.
