

# Aquilegia skinnerii 'Tequila Sunrise' Columbine



## PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Perennial
Height / Width:	18-28 in. H x 12-18 in. W
Plant Form:	Erect clumps
Flower / Fruit:	Orange and yellow, long-spurred blossoms from May to October
Leaf Color, Size:	Blue-green fern-like foliage

## GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	1-9
Soil:	Well-drained, average fertility
Water:	Best with regular water
Sun:	Light shade to full shade
Care and Pruning:	After bloom, cut back old stems for 2nd flowering, replace every 3-4 years. Reseeds prolifically. <b>CAUTION: HARMFUL IF EATEN</b>
