

Aquilegia vulgaris (Mixed Colors) European Columbine



These plants are from seeds taken from *Aquilegia vulgaris* 'Black Beauty' and do not bloom true, but are gorgeous none the less!

PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type: Perennial

Height / Width: 14 in. H x 8 in. W

Plant Form: Erect

Flower / Fruit: Charming full double flowers without the classic spurs, resemble small Dahlias, in mixed colors
Blooms spring to summer

Leaf: Green

Native To: Naturalized in eastern U.S.

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones: 1-10, 14-24

Soil: Well-drained, average fertility

Water: Best with regular water

Sun: Partial shade

Care and Pruning: After bloom, cut back old stems for 2nd flowering, replace every 3-4 years. Reseeds prolifically.
CAUTION: HARMFUL IF EATEN

GARDEN USE

Cut flower, rock gardens, used in naturalizing. Attracts hummingbirds and butterflies. Deer, rabbit, and squirrel resistant.
