PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type: Evergreen Shrub

Height/Width: 5-6 ft. H x 7 ft. W

Plant Form: Rounded mounding with profuse branching

Flower / Fruit: Abundant whitish-pink small urn-like in late winter/early spring

Leaf Color: Shiny green

Native To: Sonoma Area of California

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones: 7-9, 14-21

Soil: Tolerates sand and clay

Water: Little to moderate
Hates having wet feet

Sun: Full sun or light shade

Care and Pruning: Responds exceptionally well to pruning - even shearing

GARDEN USE One of the most popular and easy to grow manzanitas. Beautiful all year. Use as sheared screen, in large container, or as a specimen.
