PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Herbaceous Perennial
Height / Width:	4-6 ft. H x 3 ft. W
Plant Form:	Loose, branching
Flower / Fruit:	Masses of blue-violet flowers on erect, wiry, wine red stems in late summer to early fall
Leaf Color, Size:	Heart-shaped
Native To:	Eastern North America

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	1-10, 14-21
Soil:	Best growth in fertile soil
Water:	Regular
Sun:	Sun or light shade
Care and Pruning:	Divide yearly in late fall or early spring. Dig out unwanted spreading in early spring.

GARDEN USE	Abundant color in large borders or among shrubs. Large sprays effective in arrangements.
