PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Evergreen shrub
Height / Width:	3-6 ft. H x 6 ft. W
Plant Form:	Open, rounded
Flower / Fruit:	Small white flowers bloom in late winter
Leaf:	Small, serrated, green
Native To:	Northern California

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	5-11, 14-24
Soil:	Fast draining, poor, sandy
Water:	Little to moderate, water weekly until established then monthly
Sun:	Full sun
Care and Pruning:	Can shear yearly, if wanted. Cut out dead branches and thin to rejuvenate.

GARDEN USE Reliable bank and flatland cover, as hedges, and along fencelines. Withstands heat, wind and poor soil. Deer resistant.
