Plant Type:	Shrubby Perennial
Height / Width:	1½ ft. H x 2 ft. W
Plant Form:	Dense, rounded
Flower / Fruit:	Whorls of small lavender flowers
Leaf Color, Size:	Opposite pairs of roundish, inch-wide, furry gray-green
Native To:	Mediterranean region

Sunset Zones:	2, 3, 6-9, 14-24
Soil:	Well-drained
Water:	Little to moderate
Sun:	Full sun
Care and Pruning:	Cut back hard in spring before new growth starts
