| Plant Form: | Fast, rank growth every spring and summer |
| Flower / Fruit: | Slender fragrant, cone-shaped flower spikes of lilac-blue |
| Leaf Color, Size: | Light green to grayish green with silvery undersides |
| Native To: | China, Japan |

| Water: | Moderate to regular |
| Sun: | Full sun to light shade |
| Care and Pruning: | Hard prune in winter or early spring before growth begins Deadhead to prolong bloom |
