PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Deciduous shrub (except in mildest winter climates)
Height / Width:	12' x 10'
Plant Form:	Upright to arching shrub
Flower / Fruit:	Buttery yellow
Leaf Color/Size:	Gray-green, 3-4 in. long
Native To:	Hybrid between <i>B. davidii</i> (China, Japan) and <i>B. globosa</i> (Chile)

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	4-24
Soil:	Well-drained
Water:	Regular
Sun:	Sun
Care and Pruning:	Hard prune in winter or early spring before growth begins. Deadhead to prolong bloom.
