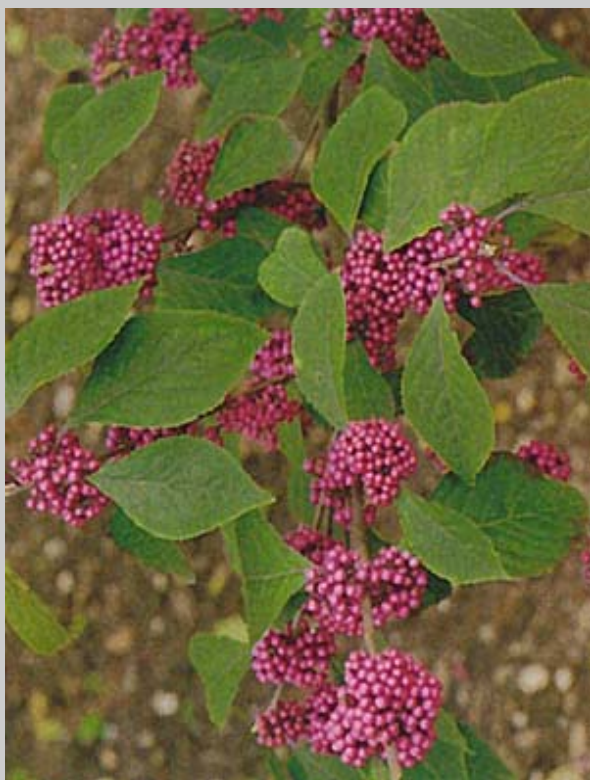


Callicarpa bodineri 'Profusion' Bodinier Beautyberry



PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Deciduous Shrub
Height / Width:	6 ft. H x 6 ft. W
Plant Form:	Graceful, arching, informal
Flower / Fruit:	Small lilac or pink flowers in summer, followed by tight clusters of little, round, violet berries persisting into winter
Leaf Color, Size:	Turns pink or orange to purple in fall
Native To:	China

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	3-9, 14-24
Soil:	Fast draining, poor, sandy
Water:	Moderate to regular
Sun:	Sun or light shade
Care and Pruning:	Prune one-third of oldest stems in late winter, or lop entire plant to ground
