Eurasian Sedge (Berkeley Sedge)



PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Grass-like Perennial
Height / Width:	1.5 ft. H x 2 ft. W
Plant Form:	Loosely arranged grass-like, arching mound
Flower / Fruit:	Spikes of greenish flowers from winter to spring
Leaf Color, Size:	Glossy green, narrow blades
Native To:	Europe (Widely sold as California native <i>C. tumulicola</i>)

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	2b-9, 11-24
Soil:	Moist fertile soils
Water:	Regular
Sun:	Partial shade
Care and Pruning:	Shear flowers when they begin to brown to keep plants tidy and prevent seeding

Create lush meadow or no-mow lawn. Borders, rock gardens, bogs, containers, water gardens, fine groundcover.
