Plant Form:	Erect, clump-forming
Flower / Fruit:	Blue, 3-in. wide, resembling ragged cornflowers Late spring to midsummer
Leaf Color, Size:	Gray-green, up to 7 in. long
Native To:	Central Europe Mountains
