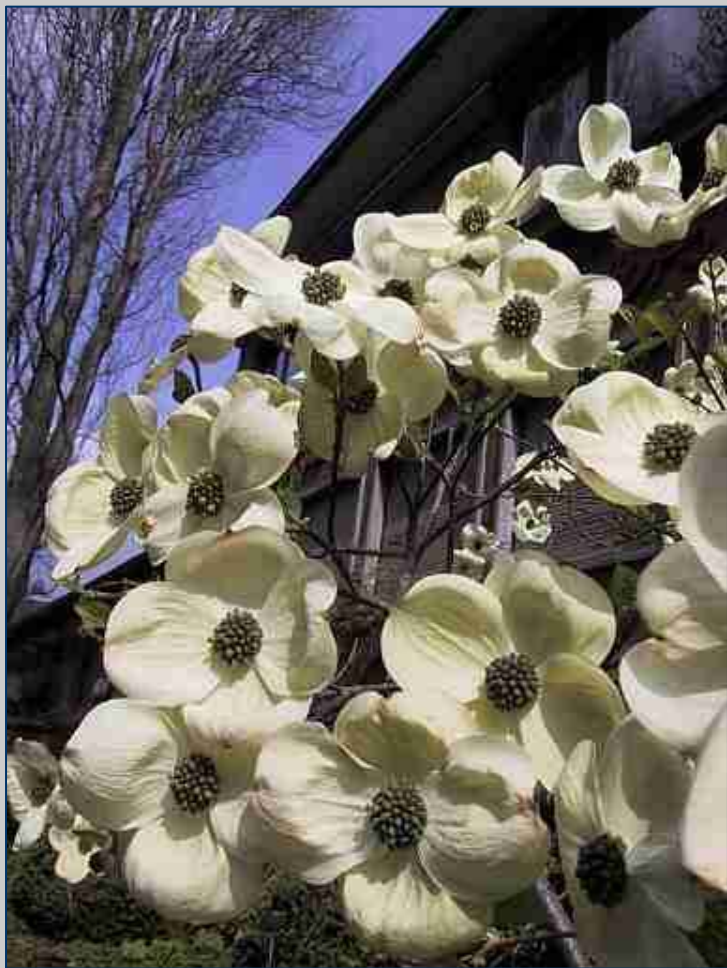


Cornus nuttallii

Pacific or Western Dogwood



PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Deciduous Tree
Height / Width:	50 ft. H x 20 ft. W
Plant Form:	Pleasing horizontal branching
Flower / Fruit:	Purple-green flower centers, surrounded by large, showy, white bracts. Red fruit in fall.
Leaf Color/Size:	Oval, 3-5 in. green leaves, turn yellow, red, and pink in autumn
Native To:	Pacific Northwest, N. California

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	3b-9, 14-20
Soil:	Exceptionally good drainage
Water:	Infrequent summer water
Sun:	Light shade
Care and Pruning:	Dislikes routine garden watering fertilizing, or pruning. Plant in cool, moist setting under high-branching trees
