

Crocosmia x crocosmiiflora Montbretia



PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Perennial from corms
Height / Width:	4ft. H x 2-3 ft. W
Plant Form:	Compact, upright clump
Flower / Fruit:	Exotic-looking, orange-red, 1½ to 2 in. across on 3-4 ft. stems, in mid-summer
Leaf:	Sword shaped, 3 ft. tall, medium green
Native To:	Tropical & Southern Africa

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	5-24
Soil:	Well-drained, enriched with organic matter
Water:	Regular during growth
Sun:	Full sun to partial shade
Care and Pruning:	Deadheading prolongs bloom. Cut to ground after foliage dies. Divide every 2-3 yrs in spring. Set corms 2 in. deep, 3 in. apart
GARDEN USE	Color accent in sunny borders. Long-lasting, elegant cut flower. Pest and disease-free.
