PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Deciduous Shrub
Height / Width:	7-10 ft. H x 6 ft. W
Plant Form:	Open, arching, informal
Flower / Fruit:	Large clusters of small, frilly, double white flowers tinged pink
Leaf Color, Size:	3-in. long, oval, scallop-toothed dull green, roughish to touch
Native To:	Japan

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	2-11, 14-17
Soil:	Excellent drainage
Water:	Regular
Sun:	Full sun or light shade
Care and Pruning:	Prune severely by cutting back wood that has flowered. Cut to outward facing side branches.

GARDEN USE

Plant among evergreens where it makes a show with late-spring bulbs. Use as informal hedges or woodland garden edges.
