

# **Epilobium canum ssp. canum**

## **California Fuchsia**



### **PLANT DESCRIPTION**

**Plant Type:** Herbaceous Woody Perennial

**Height / Width:** 1 ft. H x spreading

**Plant Form:** Informal spreading clump

**Flower / Fruit:** Tubular, vermilion to scarlet

**Leaf Color,Size:** Silver-green, oblong, silky

**Native To:** California

### **GROWING REQUIREMENTS**

**Sunset Zones:** 2-11, 14-24

**Soil:** Prefers excellent drainage

**Water:** Little to moderate. Drought tolerant, but looks best with occasional soaking in summer.

**Sun:** Sun to part shade

**Care and Pruning:** Cut back dead stems to ground (or use a weedeater) in late fall to early winter.
