

Eupatorium rugosum 'Chocolate' White Snakeroot



PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type: Herbaceous Perennial

Height / Width: 4 ft. H x 3 ft. W

Plant Form: Upright clump

Flower / Fruit: Domes of fluffy white flowers atop shiny purple stems in late summer and early fall

Leaf Color, Size: Sharp-toothed, lance-shaped to elliptic-oblong leaves (4-7 in. long) are chocolate-tinted

Native To: Eastern U.S.

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones: 1-10, 14-17

Soil: Rich

Water: Ample

Sun: Light shade in hottest climates

Care and Pruning: Deadhead spent flower heads to avoid any unwanted self-seeding (cultivar does not come true from seed).

GARDEN USE

Borders, cottage gardens, wild gardens, woodland gardens and naturalized areas.
Attract butterflies.
