

# Euphorbia cyparissias Cypress Spurge



## PLANT DESCRIPTION

<b>Plant Type:</b>	Perennial (rhizomatous) May go dormant in winter
<b>Height / Width:</b>	1 ft. H x spreads vigorously
<b>Plant Form:</b>	Feathery lax clump
<b>Flower / Fruit:</b>	Terminal clusters of yellow-green flowers in late spring to early summer (may turn orange in poor soils)
<b>Leaf:</b>	Blue-green, needle-like
<b>Native To:</b>	Europe

## GROWING REQUIREMENTS

<b>Sunset Zones:</b>	2-24
<b>Soil:</b>	Well drained
<b>Water:</b>	Little to moderate
<b>Sun:</b>	Full sun or light shade

<b>Care and Pruning:</b>	Milky white sap is irritating on contact, toxic if ingested Use skin and eye protection! Cut yellowed stalks out at base Can be invasive in good soils
