PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Evergreen Ornamental Grass
Height / Width:	1.5 ft. H x 1 ft. W
Plant Form:	Elegant, erect clump
Flower / Fruit:	Attractive tan seed heads in early summer
Leaf Color, Size:	Narrow, spruce-blue color
Native To:	Hybrid of Western North America native

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	1-10, 14-24
Soil:	Average to poor, well-drained Tolerant of wet winter soils Dislikes moist fertile soils
Water:	Moderate; tolerates more or less
Sun:	Best in sun, tolerates some shade
Care and Pruning:	Can survive years with no maintenance. Remove seed-heads to prevent self-sowing.

GARDEN USE
Hillsides, parking strips, marginal areas. Good slope stabilizer. Tolerates wind and deer. Attractive to butterflies.
