

Gaura lindheimeri 'The Bride' Guara



PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type: Herbaceous Perennial

Height/Width: 4 ft. H x 2-3 ft. W

Plant Form: Airy clump with deep taproot

Flower / Fruit: 1-in. white flowers, tinged in pink on long, thin branching spikes. Blooms from late spring to mid-fall.

Leaf: Small green, lance-shaped, stemless

Native To: Texas, Louisiana

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones: 2b-24

Soil: Sandy, loamy, well-drained

Water: Moderate, but drought-tolerant

Sun: Full sun

Care and Pruning: Tolerates heat, humidity & drought. Remove seed-bearing spikes to prolong bloom period, and prevent enthusiastic self-sowing.

GARDEN USE

Wildflower or native plant gardens, and allowed to sprawl & naturalize. Effective in sunny borders. Attracts butterflies and hummingbirds.
