

# Gomphostigma virgatum

## Otterbush



### PLANT DESCRIPTION

<b>Plant Type:</b>	Evergreen Shrub
<b>Height / Width:</b>	6-8 ft. H x 4 ft. W
<b>Plant Form:</b>	Broom-like shrub
<b>Flower / Fruit:</b>	Covered with narrow clusters of fragrant small, dainty white flowers at shoot tips. Blooms May - Sept
<b>Leaf Color, Size:</b>	Slender, flexible, silvery gray branches with silvery gray slender leaves
<b>Native To:</b>	South Africa

### GROWING REQUIREMENTS

<b>Sunset Zones:</b>	4-9, 16-26
<b>Soil:</b>	Well-drained
<b>Water:</b>	Average, do not overwater
<b>Sun:</b>	Full sun
<b>Care and Pruning:</b>	Cut back drastically after winter to encourage bushiness and more flowers for the following season
