Juniper-Leaf Grevillea



PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Evergreen Shrub
Height / Width:	2-3 ft. H x 3-5 ft. W
Plant Form:	Low, compact, spreading
Flower / Fruit:	Very showy apricot color, long bloom period starting in spring
Leaf Color, Size:	Dark green needles, fragrantly resinous
Native To:	Hybrid, originally from Australia

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	6-9, 14-24
Soil:	Well-drained, tolerant of fertility
Water:	Little water, drought-tolerant
Sun:	Full sun
Care and Pruning:	Fast growing. Prune after flowering to shape. Fertilize with low-phosphate Osmocote.

GARDEN USE Cascading bank cover, big rock gardens, rough slopes. Attractive to birds.
