

Helianthus angustifolius 'Mellow Yellow' Swamp Sunflower



PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Herbaceous Perennial
Height/Width:	6-8 ft. H x 3-5 ft. W
Plant Form:	Upright
Flower / Fruit:	Large, pastel yellow flowers in late summer through fall
Leaf:	Narrow, green
Native To:	North America

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Zones:	1-24
Soil:	Requires consistently moist soil; don't dry out between waterings
Water:	Regular
Sun:	Full sun
Care and Pruning:	Interplant with large perennials or grasses to provide support. Or cut back by one-third in early summer to encourage a bushier and more floriferous form. Self-sows freely; deadhead if you do not want volunteer seedlings.

GARDEN USE

Suitable for bogs & water gardens, wildflower gardens, or mixed into perennial beds. Good cut flower. Attracts bees, butterflies, & birds. Reported to be resistant to deer.
