

Hemerocallis 'Stella d'Oro' Dwarf Daylily



PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Perennial from tuberous roots
Height / Width:	2 ft. H x 2 ft. W
Plant Form:	Arching, dense clump
Flower / Fruit:	Profuse, star-shaped, bright yellow with ruffled edges and deeper yellow throats, from spring into summer
Leaf Color, Size:	Green, strap-like
Native To:	Hybrid

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	1-24
Soil:	Well-drained, amended
Water:	Regular
Sun:	Full sun, partial shade in hottest climates
Care and Pruning:	Cut spent bloom stalks to ground. Leaf fans can be cut back hard in fall. Divide in fall when crowded (every 3-6 yrs).
