

Hibiscus moscheutos 'Luna White' Hibiscus



PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Herbaceous Perennial
Height / Width:	3 ft. H x 2 ft. W
Plant Form:	Shrubby, rounded; fast-growing
Flower / Fruit:	Large, white with pastel pink edges and dark pink eye, 6-8in. wide bloom from mid-summer to frost
Leaf Color, Size:	Oval, toothed, deep green above, whitish below
Native To:	Eastern U.S.

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	2-24
Soil:	Moist, organically rich soils
Water:	Regular, deep
Sun:	Full sun
Care and Pruning:	One of last plants to emerge in spring. Side dress with organic matter in early spring. Mulch. Cut back stems to approximately 3-4 in. tall in late autumn.
GARDEN USE	Cottage garden, containers, perennial garden, water's edge Very long bloom period
