PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Herbaceous Perennial
Height / Width:	7 ft. H x 3 ft. W
Plant Form:	Shrubby, full; Fast-growing
Flower / Fruit:	Largest flowers of all hibiscus (6-12in. wide), white with deep rose center, August to frost
Leaf Color, Size:	Oval, toothed, deep green above, whitish below
Native To:	Eastern U.S.

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	2-24
Soil:	Moist
Water:	Regular to wet
Sun:	Full sun
Care and Pruning:	Dies to ground in winter; one of last plants to emerge in spring. Side dress with organic matter before spring growth. Protect from wind. Mulch.
