PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Deciduous Shrub
Height / Width:	6-9 ft. H x 6+ ft. W
Plant Form:	Upright and compact when young, spreading and open with age
Flower / Fruit:	White blooms; mid-summer to frost
Leaf:	4-in.-long, coarsely toothed
Native To:	Eastern Asia

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	2-24
Soil:	Average, well-drained, loam
Water:	Moderate
Sun:	Full sun to partial shade
Care and Pruning:	Prune to control growth and shape. Side dress with organic matter before new spring growth begins. Easily trained to single trunk tree or espalier.

GARDEN USE Hedge or border specimen. Good cut flowers. Attracts butterflies.
