

Hypericum androsaemum 'Albury Purple'

St. Johnswort



PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type: Semi-evergreen Shrub

Height / Width: 2 ft. H x 2 ft. W

Plant Form: Arching

Flower / Fruit: Clusters of $\frac{3}{4}$ in. golden yellow flowers in summer, followed by inedible berry-like fruits maturing from red to purple to black

Leaf Color, Size: Medium green, 4-in.-long x 2-in.-wide; new growth flushed dusky purple

Native To: Europe, Western Asia

Sunset Zones: 3b-24

Soil: Rich, loamy, well-drained

Water: Moderate

Sun: Partial shade

Care / Pruning: Neat and easy
