PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type: Deciduous shrub

Height/Width: 8-10 ft. H x 8-10 ft. W

Plant Form: Open, graceful, arching

Flower / Fruit: Double yellow, 1¼-in. flowers
from spring-summer, sometimes
early fall

Leaf: Tooth edged, heavily veined,
somewhat triangular 2-4 in. long,
bright green turning yellow in fall

Native To: China

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones: 2-23

Soil: Garden soil

Water: Moderate to regular

Sun: Part shade

Care and Pruning: Give room to display arched form,
remove suckers and prune dead
wood after bloom
