

Lavatera thuringiaca 'Barnsley' Tree Mallow



PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Evergreen shrub
Height / Width:	6–8 ft. H x 6 ft. W
Plant Form:	Long, arching branches
Flower / Fruit:	3 in. light pink with deep pink centers, similar to hollyhocks, from late spring until frost
Leaf Color, Size:	Maple-like, green, 2½-in.-long
Native To:	Central & Southeastern Europe

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	2–9, 14–24
Soil:	Not too rich
Water:	Low to moderate
Sun:	Part shade
Care and Pruning:	Easy-to-grow. Cut back hard to keep compact. Winter protection Zones 2 & 3
