PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Herbaceous Perennial
Height / Width:	4 ft. x 1.5 ft. W
Plant Form:	Tall, upright, clump-forming
Flower / Fruit:	Small light purple flowers on showy bloom spikes open from the top downward
Leaf Color, Size:	Linear, lance-shaped, green
Native To:	Eastern & Central N. America

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	1-10, 14-24
Soil:	Well-drained, moderately fertile
Water:	Regular
Sun:	Full sun
Care and Pruning:	Sensitive to soggy soil during winter dormancy. When performance declines, divide clumps in early spring.
