PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type: Perennial

Height / Width: 2 ft. H x 1.5 ft. W

Plant Form: Clump

Flower / Fruit: Branching clusters of $\frac{3}{4}$ -in. white flowers on 2½-ft. stems from late spring to midsummer

Leaf Color, Size: Bright green swordlike leaves in fans

Native To: New Zealand

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones: 8, 9, 14-24

Soil: Moderately fertile, humus-rich, well-drained

Water: Regular

Sun: Light shade to full shade

Care and Pruning: Cut back seedheads and dead leaves as needed. Can be divided
