PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type: Perennial

Height/Width: 3 ft. H x 3-6 ft. W

Plant Form: Upright

Flower / Fruit: Open clusters of 2 in. tubular orange-red flowers with yellow throats over long summer season

Leaf: Narrow, green, saw-edged leaf

Native To: Arizona and Mexico

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones: 7-9, 12-24

Soil: Well drained, tolerant

Water: Little to regular

Sun: Full sun, partial

Care and Pruning: Spreads by underground rhizomes
Endures considerable neglect
If needed, cut to base to refresh
