PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Perennial
Height / Width:	4 ft. H x 2 ft. W
Plant Form:	Erect clump
Flower / Fruit:	Loose clusters of 1 in. yellow flowers with red-brown centers; blooms in summer
Leaf:	Reddish-purple foliage
Native To:	Northeastern U.S.

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	1-9, 14-21
Soil:	Not fussy
Water:	Moderate water
Sun:	Morning sun, afternoon shade
Care and Pruning:	Spreading growth if given ample moisture
