

Miscanthus sinensis 'Morning Light' Maiden Grass



PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Perennial Ornamental Grass
Height / Width:	3-6 ft. H x 2-3 ft. W
Plant Form:	Clump-forming
Flower / Fruit:	Flowers have a pink tinge in late fall, setting off the deep reddish-bronze, 5-6 ft. high plumes, dries to a fluffy cream color
Leaf:	Narrow silver band on leaf edges
Native To:	Asia

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	2-24
Soil:	Not fussy
Water:	Moderate to regular
Sun:	Full sun to partial shade
Care and Pruning:	Cut to ground in late Feb/early March when new growth begins. Occasionally clean up old leaves.

GARDEN USE

Accent plant, mass plantings, slopes and banks, containers. Brings movement into the landscape. Shimmers beautifully in morning and evening light.
