

Miscanthus sinensis 'Variegatus' Variegated Maiden Grass



PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type: Ornamental grass

Height/Width: 3-6 ft. H x 3-6 ft. W

Plant Form: Loosely-upright clump

Flower/Fruit: Gorgeous reddish-brown plumes in September, gradually turning to silvery plumes in the fall

Leaf: Graceful creamy-white-striped leaves that shimmer

Native To: Asia

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Zones: 2-24

Soil: Not fussy

Water: Moderate

Sun: Full sun or part shade

Care and Pruning: Cut foliage to the ground in late winter/early spring just before new shoots appear. Tends to flop under weight of blooms, may need staking.

GARDEN USE Good accent or specimen, groups, massed, or as a screen. Good for cut flowers. Deer resistant.
