Wire Vine



PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Evergreen Vine
Height/Width:	20 – 30 ft. H as climber 20 – 30 ft. W as sprawler
Plant Form:	Twining vine. Climber or sprawler, spreads by rhizomes. Dense tangle of thin black or brown stems.
Flower / Fruit:	Insignificant
Leaf:	Light green, 1/2 - 3/4 in. long – may be oval, rounded, fiddle-shaped
Native To:	New Zealand

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	8, 9, 14-24
Soil:	Not fussy
Water:	Regular
Sun:	Full sun or part shade
Care and Pruning:	Curb growth by shearing or cutting back as much as desired; plant will regrow.

GARDEN USE Good for beach planting, screen. As groundcover, spreads over a 30 ft. wide area.
