

# Nandina domestica Heavenly Bamboo



## PLANT DESCRIPTION

<b>Plant Type:</b>	Evergreen shrub
<b>Height / Width:</b>	6-8 ft. H x 3-4 ft. W
<b>Plant Form:</b>	Upright, weeping Slow to moderate growth
<b>Flower / Fruit:</b>	Creamy white blossoms in loose, erect, 6-12-in. clusters in late spring or early summer. Shiny red berries follow the flowers.
<b>Leaf:</b>	Foliage emerges pinkish & bronzy red, turns light green; purple and bronze tints in fall and often fiery red in winter
<b>Native To:</b>	China and Japan

## GROWING REQUIREMENTS

<b>Sunset Zones:</b>	4-24
<b>Soil:</b>	Does best in rich soil
<b>Water:</b>	Little to regular
<b>Sun:</b>	Some shade in hottest climates
<b>Care and Pruning:</b>	Cut oldest canes to ground each year before new growth in spring

**GARDEN USE** Light, airy-looking hedge, screen, or tub plant. Good for bonsai and in narrow restricted spaces. Good filler in bouquets.
