Plant Type:	Herbaceous Perennial
Height / Width:	3 ft. H x 3 ft. W
Plant Form:	Rounded
Flower / Fruit:	Profuse number of loose lavender-blue flower spikes in early summer
Leaf Color/Size:	Silvery green, aromatic and attractive to cats
Native To:	Garden Hybrid

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	1-24
Soil:	Not fussy. Do not overwater
Water:	Low to moderate; fairly drought-tolerant once established
Sun:	Full sun or partial shade
Care and Pruning:	Fast growth; shearing old flowers will bring on another bloom
