PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type: Shrubby Perennial

Height / Width: 1 ft. H x 1 ft. W

Plant Form: Trailing

Flower / Fruit: Dark wine-purple, in small clusters on slender, branching, trailing stems; spring thru summer

Leaf: Silvery-gray, velvety, heart-shaped 1½ in. across

Native To: South Africa

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Zones: 8, 9, 12-14, 18-21

Soil: Fast draining, good soil

Water: Moderate to regular

Sun: Part shade

Care and Pruning: Pinch growing tips of young plants, remove dead leaves and old flower stalks in winter
