PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Shrubby Perennial
Height / Width:	3-4 ft. H x 3-4 ft. W
Plant Form:	Upright, woody-based
Flower / Fruit:	Widely branched sprays of small lavender-blue flowers forming a soft haze above foliage. Blooms late spring-summer.
Leaf:	Gray-green along stems
Native To:	Western/Central Asia

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	2-24
Soil:	Fast draining, tolerant
Water:	Little to moderate, drought tolerant
Sun:	Full sun
Care and Pruning:	May spread to form colonies. Cut nearly to ground each spring before growth begins.
