

Phalaris arundinacea picta 'Feeseey' Ribbon Grass



PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Perennial Grass
Height / Width:	1½ - 2 ft. H x spreading
Plant Form:	Clump; spreads indefinitely by underground runners
Flower / Fruit:	White airy flower clusters, aging to pale brown
Leaf:	Flat, arching, green and white striped, 6-12-in.-long blades (2/3 in. wide); pink tinged in spring, creamy white by summer
Native To:	North America, Eurasia

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	1-10,14-24
Soil:	Tolerates moist, wet conditions, or well-drained garden soil
Water:	Moderate to regular
Sun:	Full sun or partial shade in hottest climates
Care and Pruning:	To keep plant in-bounds in wet areas, grow in large containers or use control methods as for running bamboos

GARDEN USE Dense, weed-free groundcover in areas where invasiveness is not a concern. Boggy areas, water gardens (submerged in several inches of water).
