Greek Jerusalem Sage



PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type: Perennial

Height / Width: 4-6 ft. H x 3 ft. W

Plant Form: Vigorous large clumps with spreading stems

Flower / Fruit: Purple or purplish-pink whorls around stems, through summer

Leaf Color/Size: Attractive heart-shaped, gray-green, wrinkled, almost all parts of the plant sticky to the touch

Native To: Greece, Turkey, Yugoslavia

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones: 2-24

Soil: Not particular, well-drained

Water: Little to moderate water. More moisture in hot-summer regions.

Sun: Full sun, tolerates partial shade

Care and Pruning: Cut back to crown after flowering to rejuvenate
