PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Perennial
Height/Width:	2-4 ft. H x 2-3 ft. W
Plant Form:	Upright
Flower/Fruit:	Fragrant, 1-in. pure white, in large, dome-shaped clusters, throughout summer
Leaf:	Green, narrow lance-shaped
Native To:	Eastern North America

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	1-14, 18-21
Soil:	Good garden soil
Water:	Regular
Sun:	Part sun, good air circulation
Care and Pruning:	Pinch stem tips of young plants to induce branching. Divide every few years, replanting young shoots from outside of clump. Stake per need. Mildew-resistant
