Terrestrial Bromeliad



PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type: Evergreen Perennial

Height / Width: 2 ft. H x 2 ft. W

Plant Form: Arching, clumping

Flower / Fruit: Many yellowish green funnel-shaped flowers with dark gray calyxes on graceful 3 feet tall stalks.

Leaf Color, Size: Linear-lance-shaped, finely toothed to 24 in. long

Native To: Bolivia and N. Argentina

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

USDA Zones: 9-11, Hardy to 20°F

Soil: Good drainage

Water: Low to average
Drought tolerant

Sun: Part shade

Care / Pruning: Offsets freely

GARDEN USE

Desert or alpine gardens, mixed borders or raised beds. One of the fastest blooming puyas. Deer resistant.
